- 1. Why do you think that the story of Jesus rising from the dead is difficult for some people to believe?
- 2. Read Mark 16:1-7. Do you believe Jesus actually rose from the dead? If so, why do you believe?
- 3. Pastor Mark argues that the Christian Faith is not based a philosophy or a spiritual metaphor or a set of rules, but rather on a historical event. Why is that important?
- 4. How would you define "inner peace?"
- 5. What do you think Jesus meant when he said, "My peace I give to you, I do not give the world's peace, but my peace"?
- 6. Why do you think so many in America have been reporting a lack of peace, contentment and personal satisfaction over the past few years?
- 7. What do you do on a daily basis to build and strengthen your inner peace and your relationship with the Lord?
