- 4. Think of a time when you wanted to go your own way and do your own thing. What was the situation? Did you follow through? How did that work out?
- 5. Read Genesis 1:27. What does it mean to be created in the image of God?
- 6. Read Genesis 2: 15-17. God gave Adam and Eve the choice to follow Him, His ways, and His direction with one simple rule. Describe a time when one simple rule was set for you to follow. What influenced you to follow the rule, or to break it?



- 7. Free will is our capacity to choose between possible courses of action unimpeded. Our capacity to react any way we want. If God is sovereign, if God is all-knowing, if God is in control, do you believe that He is directing your path or is God dictating it?
- 8. Have you ever had a controlling friend, relative, significant other or boss? Have you ever felt manipulated by someone? Describe how you felt living through that situation.
- 9. What is the difference between submitting to God and being controlled by God?
- 10. Describe a time when you felt guilt or sadness or insecurity or hatred lingering within you. Were you waiting for someone or something to change your scenario? Are you still waiting?
- 11. Free will means that we have a choice to turn toward God, to fix our eyes clearly on Him, to trust in Him and follow Him. Read Matthew 11:29. What does this verse tell us about our choice?
