IN THE BEGINNING | GENESIS 1:1-3,24-27

- Two of the most important questions we must answer in life are: "How did we get here?" and "Why are we here?" Why are these important questions for helping us form a meaningful philosophy for living?
- 2. What does the creation story of Genesis tell us about how we got here?
- 3. The creation story of Genesis does not necessarily support the findings of modern-day archeology and geology. It also does not fit easily with the scientific theory of evolution. How might we reconcile the differences between the Bible and science?
- 4. Pastor Mark points out that modern-day Americans spend much less time outdoors in creation than previous generations. Why do you think this is true?
- 5. How can parents encourage their children to spend more time connecting with creation? How can adults model the importance of connecting with God through creation for children and teens?
- 6. What does it mean to you that God has declared creation to be "very good?"

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- 7. What is your favorite way of experiencing the beauty and goodness of God's creation?
- 8. How do you reconcile the beauty and goodness of God's creation with the fact that nature can sometimes be brutal and deadly?
- 9. Human beings are the culmination and climax of God's creation. What do you think it means when the Bible declares that we are "made in the image of God?"
- 10. What do you think is the difference between worshiping nature and encountering God through nature?
- 11. How does the knowledge that human beings are made in the image of God impact the way we treat other people?
